A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF JOINING THE GREAT TRAILS STATE COALITION IN
2025

WHEREAS, the North Carolina General Assembly has established the Great Trails State Day as the 3rd Saturday of October every year, and

WHEREAS, the value of trails as safe places for people to get outdoors for their physical and mental health and sense of wellbeing has been demonstrated; and

WHEREAS, trails and greenways provide key amenities to neighborhoods and are often the centerpiece of a community bringing people together to exercise, play and connect with nature; and

WHEREAS, the parks, greenways, trails and natural areas in our communities and region should be welcoming to all and provide a common ground for people of all ages, abilities and backgrounds to access our rich and diverse natural, cultural, and historic resources; and

WHEREAS, trails offer quality-of-life benefits to all as expressions of local community character and pride, as outdoor workshops for science education, as tools for economic revitalization, as free resources for healthy recreation, as accessible alternative transportation, and as sites for social and cultural events; and

WHEREAS, trails have significant impact on the economic viability of the community through increased levels of tourism, enhanced property values, as well as the ability to attract and retain businesses; and

WHEREAS, according to a NC State study on shared use paths, every \$1 spent on greenway construction generates \$1.72 annually from local business revenue, sales tax revenue, and benefits related to health and transportation; and

WHEREAS, the Piedmont Triad Regional Council is committed to supporting and implementing regional trails through Piedmont Legacy Trails and other regional trail project and wants to support the work of the Great Trails State Coalition to secure state funding for greenway and trail construction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Executive Committee of the Piedmont Triad Regional Council supports joining the Great Trails State Coalition in 2025.
